## TURLOCK BUSINESSES IN THE NEWS

#### September 2023

Throughout the month of September 2023, numerous Turlock businesses found themselves spotlighted in the local news.

A major highlight featured a story identifying Monte Vista Crossings as one of the top retail power centers in the nation. A retail power center is defined as a large retail property featuring three or more anchor tenants/"big box" stores, and an array of smaller retailers, restaurants, and other shopping options sprinkled between. Monte Vista Crossings ranked #9 in the county, and #5 in the state of California as a major power retail center. The article also shared how Turlock was one of two cities within Stanislaus County that experienced a growth in quarterly sales tax numbers. Turlock experienced a 13.8% increase, while Patterson showed a 5.2% increase in quarterly sales tax figures.
